

An owner who has been served with a Dangerous Dog Order may, under section 349-16 of Chapter 349 of the Toronto Municipal Code, apply for a hearing to the Dangerous Dog Review Tribunal to appeal an officer's determination of a dangerous dog.

Appeal Procedure

This request for appeal form and the appeal fee must be received by the City no later than 30 days after the date the Dangerous Dog order was served on the dog owner. Failure to file an appeal within this time limit will result in the request for appeal being rejected.
