Council members are appointed by right-of-office to the boards of BIAs in their wards.

Fairbank Village

The removal of two (2) directors from the Fairbank Village BIA Board of Management will increase the number of vacancies on the board from zero (0) to two (2). Quorum will be reduced from four (4) to three (3).
