
On June 10, 2024, The 519 Board of Management (the "Board") approved its updated procedural by-law and a request to expand The 519's Council approved Catchment in accordance with the *City of Toronto Act* and the Association of Community Centres Relationship Framework. The following motion was approved unanimously by the Board and we are seeking Council approval to:

- (1) adopt the General By-law No.2 – 2024 attached in the **REPORT: General By-Law No 2 of The 519 – June 10th, 2024**, with such by-law coming into force on the day it is ratified by City Council;
- (2) repeal The 519 Board of Management By-law No. 1 (Constitution) September 25, 2007, as amended, upon General By-law No. 2 – 2024 coming into force;
- (3) endorse the expanded catchment area as proposed in General By-law #2; and
- (4) request that the City Manager forward the Board's decision to Toronto City Council, which requests the ratification of General By-law No. 2 – 2024 and expansion of the catchment area, and authorizes the Board Secretary to forward the Board's decision and request to the City Manager for action.

Accordingly, we are forwarding the report and request for action by the City Manager.
