## Re: Agenda Item 18.2 EX18.2: Expanding Incentives for Purpose-Built Rental Housing (Ward All)

This letter is being submitted on behalf of NAIOP Greater Toronto. With over 1,200 members from approximately 300 companies in the GTA, NAIOP represents developers, owners and related professionals in office, industrial, retail, mixed use and multiresidential real estate.

Thank you for the opportunity to submit comments with respect to agenda item EX18.2: Expanding Incentives for Purpose-Built Rental Housing (Ward All). We are writing in support of a letter dated November 4, 2024, from the Building Industry and Land Development Association (BILD) on this initiative.

NAIOP appreciates and supports the City's goal of building more housing to meet demand, but the recommendations in the staff report do not go far enough to create an environment that is conducive to that goal.

In order to achieve this goal, NAIOP urges the City of Toronto to:

- Provide a full exemption of development charges for all purpose-built rental housing units, without additional conditions; and
- Provide a full exemption from property taxes for all purpose-built rental housing units for a period of at least 20 years, without additional conditions.
