

## **Parking Amendment - Sable Street**

**To:** Etobicoke York Community Council

**Wards:** Ward 5 – York South-Weston

### **SUMMARY**

---

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is recommending that parking be prohibited on the east side of Sable Street, from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, between Densley Avenue and the northerly limit of Sable Street. The proposed parking amendment will deter day time parking at this location and will improve vehicular movements by maintaining clear passage for vehicles.

### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

---

The Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. Etobicoke York Community Council prohibit parking on the east side of Sable Street, from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, between Densley Avenue and the north end of Sable Street.

### **FINANCIAL IMPACT**

---

The signage costs associated with the proposed amendments are approximately \$1000. Funding is available within the Transportation Services interim 2024 Operating Budget.

### **DECISION HISTORY**

---

This report addresses a new initiative.

## COMMENTS

---

Transportation Services received a request, along with a petition from the Ward Councillor, on behalf of businesses on Sable Street, to prohibit parking on the east side of Sable Street, from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, between Densley Avenue and the north end of Sable Street to deter day-time parking on one side of the street to alleviate congestion and allow better maneuverability.

### Existing Conditions

Sable Street is characterized by the following conditions:

- It is a two-lane, north-south, local roadway
- It operates two-way traffic on a pavement width of approximately 9 metres
- The daily two-way traffic volume is approximately 500 vehicles
- The regulatory speed limit is 30 km
- Heavy trucks are permitted at all times
- There is no TTC service provided
- There is a sidewalk located on east side of the street

The unsigned statutory three-hour maximum parking limit is in effect at all times on both sides of Sable Street.

### Proposed Changes

The proposed parking prohibition on the east side of Sable Street, from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. from Monday to Friday, between Densley Avenue and the north end of Sable Street will enhance two-way traffic and deter vehicles parking on both side of the Sable Street.

A map of the area and proposed marking amendment(s) is included in Attachment 1.

The Ward Councillor has been advised of the recommendation of this staff report.
