Introduction of Overnight On-Street Permit Parking Area 11 - Longbourne Drive

SUMMARY

As the Toronto Transit Commission (TTC) operates a transit service on Longbourne Drive, City Council approval of this report is required.

Transportation Services is recommending that overnight on-street permit parking be introduced on Longbourne Drive, between Willowridge Road and Redgrave Drive from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., on an area named basis, within newly created Permit Parking Area 11.

Residents requested the implementation of overnight on-street permit parking on Longbourne Drive to accommodate their long-term parking needs.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Director, Permits and Enforcement, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. City Council authorize permit parking to be in effect from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., seven days a week on the south side of Longbourne Drive between Willowridge Road and Redgrave Drive within the newly created permit parking area 11 as shown in appendix A

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The estimated funding to implement permit parking is \$400 which is available within Transportation Services 2023 Operating Budget. The maximum annual revenue that could potentially be generated if all parking spaces are occupied by a permit holder is \$7,523.

DECISION HISTORY

At the September Etobicoke York Community Council, a request was made by the local councillor to install overnight permit parking on Longbourne Drive to address the needs of residents. The polling requirement was waived by the local councillor.

COMMENTS

A request was received from the Ward Councillor, on behalf of area residents, to introduce overnight on-street permit parking program on Longbourne Drive between Willowridge Road and Redgrave Drive to accommodate their long-term parking needs without being subject to tagging by Toronto Police Service, Parking Enforcement Unit.

Existing Conditions

Longbourne Drive is characterized by the following conditions:

- It is a two-lane, east-west local roadway
- It operates two-way traffic on a pavement width of approximately 8.5 metres
- There are sidewalks located on both sides of the street
- There is TTC service provided by the 111 East Mall bus

The unsigned statutory three-hour maximum parking limit is in effect at all times on both sides of Longbourne Drive between Willowridge Road and Redgrave Drive.

Polling Results

In accordance with Municipal Code Chapter 925 and following a request by Councillor Crisanti, the polling requirement was waived at the September 18th, 2023, meeting of Etobicoke York Community Council.

Maps of the proposed new permit parking area 11 is included in Attachment 1.

The Ward Councillor has been advised of the recommendation in this report.
