Metrolinx Eglinton Crosstown LRT - Traffic Control Signals at Eglinton Avenue West and Keelesdale Road

SUMMARY

As the Toronto Transit Commission (TTC) operates a transit service on Eglinton Avenue West, City Council approval of this report is required.

As part of the Eglinton Crosstown LRT (ECLRT) project, Metrolinx has installed a new traffic signal at the intersection of Eglinton Avenue West and Keelesdale Road (approximately 148 metres west of Black Creek Drive). This report seeks City Council approval for the new traffic control signals to enable inspections, acceptance, and activation.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Deputy General Manager, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. City Council authorize the installation of traffic control signals at the intersection of Eglinton Avenue West and a point approximately 148 metres west of Black Creek Drive.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no financial impact to the City. Metrolinx and their Project Co. are responsible for all costs, including payment of fees to the City for the right-of-way occupancy permits.

DECISION HISTORY

City Council at its meeting on May 7, 2013, adopted Item EX31.4 entitled "Environmental Project Report Addendum for Eglinton Crosstown Light Rail Transit (Jane Street to Keelesdale Park)" and supported the LRT alignment changes from Jane Street to Keelesdale Park.

COMMENTS

As part of the ECLRT project, Metrolinx has converted the right-in/right-out stopcontrolled intersection of Eglinton Avenue West and Keelesdale Road (located approximately 148 metres west of Black Creek Drive) to a full-moves signalized intersection. This change was essential to facilitate TTC bus access to the ECLRT Mount Dennis Station. Additionally, the traffic signal installation will enhance traffic management, improve pedestrian safety, and support the seamless integration of transit services in the area. Figure 1 below shows the location of the intersection of Eglinton Avenue West and Keelesdale Road.
