

Parking Amendments - Monogram Place

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is recommending that the existing parking regulations on the north and south sides of Monogram Place be amended to prohibit stopping at all times. The proposed amendment will deter parking.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. Etobicoke York Community Council rescind the existing parking prohibition in effect at all times on the north side of Monogram Place, between Islington Avenue and a point 82 metres west of Islington Avenue.
2. Etobicoke York Community Council rescind the existing maximum two-hour parking regulation in effect at all times, on the north side of Monogram Place, between a point 82 metres west of Islington Avenue and the west end of Monogram Place.
3. Etobicoke York Community Council rescind the existing parking prohibition in effect at all times on the south side of Monogram Place, between Islington Avenue and the west end of Monogram Place.
4. Etobicoke York Community Council prohibit stopping at all times on both sides of Monogram Place between Islington Avenue and the west end of Monogram Place.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The signage costs associated with the proposed amendments are approximately \$3200.00. Funding is available within the Transportation Services current Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

Community Council, at its meeting on February 14, 2012, adopted Item EY13.33 entitled "Parking Regulation Amendments - Monogram Place" allowing maximum two-hour parking on the north side of Monogram Place to accommodate additional daytime parking for the abutting properties for their customers and clients on-street.

COMMENTS

The Ward Councillor, on behalf of neighbourhood residents, requested that stopping be prohibited at all times on both sides of Monogram Place between Islington Avenue and the west limit of Monogram Place. Large trucks that are not affiliated with the addresses on Monogram Place are utilizing the street for parking. Prohibiting stopping will deter vehicles from utilizing Monogram Place for parking/storage.

Existing Conditions

Monogram Place is characterized by the following conditions:

- It is a two-lane, east-west, local roadway
- It operates two-way traffic on a pavement width of approximately 15 to 9.6 metres
- The speed limit is 30 km/h
- Heavy trucks are prohibited at all times
- There is no TTC service provided
- There is a sidewalk located on the north side of the street

The parking regulations on Monogram Place, within the subject section are as follows:

North side

- No parking anytime, between Islington Avenue and a point 82 metres west.
- Maximum two-hour parking, at all times between a point 82 metres west of Islington Avenue and the west end of Monogram Place.

South side

- No parking anytime

Proposed Changes

The Ward Councillor, on behalf of area residents and businesses requested that stopping be prohibited on both sides of Monogram Place between Islington Avenue and the west end of Monogram Place. This will replace both the existing "No Parking Anytime" regulations on a portion of the north side and all of the south side of the street. In addition, the existing maximum two-hour parking regulation on the north side of Monogram Place, between a point 82 metres west of Islington Avenue and the east end of Monogram Place, will be replaced with no stopping.

The intent of the existing two-hour parking was to provide overflow parking for the abutting properties on the north side of Monogram Place. However, the businesses that were utilizing this area are no longer operating at the abutting properties and there is no longer need for parking on Monogram Place. There have been concerns from local residents that Monogram Place is being utilized by large vehicles for parking/storage

and are not affiliated with addresses on Monogram Place. Prohibiting stopping will deter vehicles from utilizing Monogram Place for parking/storage.

A map of the area and proposed parking amendments is included in Attachment 1.

The Ward Councillor has been advised of the recommendations of this staff report.
