RE: Walk-On Motion on Changing Pavement Markings at Finch Ave West and Wilmington Ave, and Restoring Painted Cycling Lanes along Faywood Blvd

Dear Members of the Infrastructure and Environment Committee:

Our office has received numerous inquiries from my constituents with regards to the painted cycling lanes along Wilmington Avenue/Faywood Boulevard. Specifically, the solid white line that is present at the intersection of Finch Avenue West and Wilmington Avenue and painted cycling lanes along Faywood Boulevard. Thus, I hereby kindly request Transportation Services staff to change the solid line into a dashed line to aid drivers who are turning right from Wilmington Avenue onto Finch Avenue West and to restore the painted cycling lanes along Faywood Boulevard.

Recommendations:

1. City Council direct the General Manager, Transportation Services to change the solid white line at the intersection of Finch Avenue West and Wilmington Avenue to a dashed line and to restore the painted cycling lanes along Faywood Boulevard between Sheppard Avenue West and Wilson Avenue.
