Please add my comments to the agenda for the May 28, 2024 Infrastructure and Environment Committee meeting on item 2024.IE14.3, Cycling Network Plan Update (2025 - 2027)

I understand that my comments and the personal information in this email will form part of the public record and that my name will be listed as a correspondent on agendas and minutes of City Council or its committees. Comments: The Impact Analyses attached to the meeting agenda do not include any data on how, if at all, the expansion of the bike lane network to date has affected the items covered in the analyses. Neither do they take into consideration the impact on local businesses, diversion of traffic onto residential streets or ridership uptake. At a virtual town hall hosted by councillor Morley, a promise was made that the City would undertake a study in May to assess these impacts. I do not see any reference to that study in the materials. Can council or staff address please this at the meeting.
