Dear Chair McKelvie and Committee Members,

I am writing to ask your consideration regarding continuing to study the feasibility of the West Scarborough Rail Path,and making the results of the study available to the public.

The West Scarborough Rail Path is a critical component of creating a Scarborough that is more connected for cyclists and pedestrians, allowing people to travel through their community in ways that are safe, healthy and reliable. The path would provide a vital connection between the Meadoway and Taylor Creek, connecting a trail network directly towards downtown Toronto while intersecting with three subway stations as well as the future Line 5 Eglinton.
