It's OK* Studios is a new independent Black-led and operated, interdisciplinary, multipurpose arts space, that opened its doors in Toronto's historic Queen West Neighbourhood Summer 2022. Transformed from a vacant retail building in the historic Queen West district, the space is a hub for artistic growth and development, a vibrant gathering place for Toronto's Black artistic community. This space is developed and managed by It's OK*, a successful performance series and collaborative led by cultural programmers Said Yassin and Chris Wilson.

It's OK* Studios
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In 2022, **It's OK* Studios** opened its doors at **468 Queen St. W.**, offering a 10,000 square-foot venue that serves as a vibrant two-floor community hub. This versatile space is well-suited for a variety of events, including live music performances, screenings, gallery openings, and more. With a capacity of 200 people, the venue is equipped with a full PA system that envelops the entire space in high-quality sound, creating an ideal environment for both amplified and acoustic presentations.

In addition to its event capabilities, It's OK* Studios features amenities such as a community library, a gallery, a social gathering and collaboration space. It is also equipped with a 120" Elunevision Motorized Screen and a 7000 Lumen Panasonic Projector, making it perfect for screenings and immersive gallery experiences.
