RE: Speed Humps and Digital Speed Indicator on Glengrove

Dear Chair and Members,

Car thefts and violent car jacking is on the rise across the City. Recently, a resident in my ward had their car stolen from their home at gun point.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That North York Community Council:

1. Directed the Director of Traffic Management, Transportation Services, to request the City Clerk to poll eligible householders on Glengrove Avenue, between Avenue Road and Glen Rush Boulevard to determine whether residents support the installation of traffic calming, in accordance with the City of Toronto Traffic Calming Policy.
2. Subject to favourable results of the poll:
 - a. authorized the installation of traffic calming (speed humps and digital speed indicators) on Glengrove Avenue, between Avenue Road and Glen Rush Boulevard on an urgent basis given the use of the street as a throughfare for car thefts
 - b. directed the City Solicitor to prepare a by-law to alter sections of the roadway to install 4 speed humps on Glengrove Avenue, between Avenue Road and Glen Rush Boulevard, for traffic calming purposes
