Constructed in 1927, the subject property, known as The Merlan, holds design value as a representative example of an early-20th century apartment building with Edwardian Classical detailing. The property is associated with architect Norman Alexander Armstrong, and is an early example of Armstrong's apartment building design in Toronto. Contextually, the property contributes to a collection of early-20th century brick walk-up apartment buildings on Isabella Street and the surrounding Church-Wellesley neighbourhood.
