

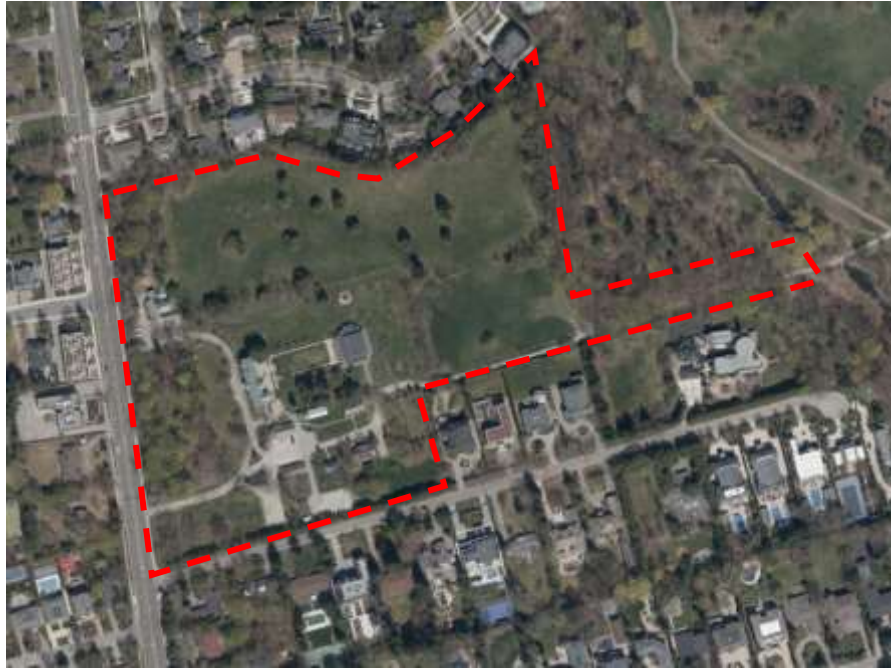


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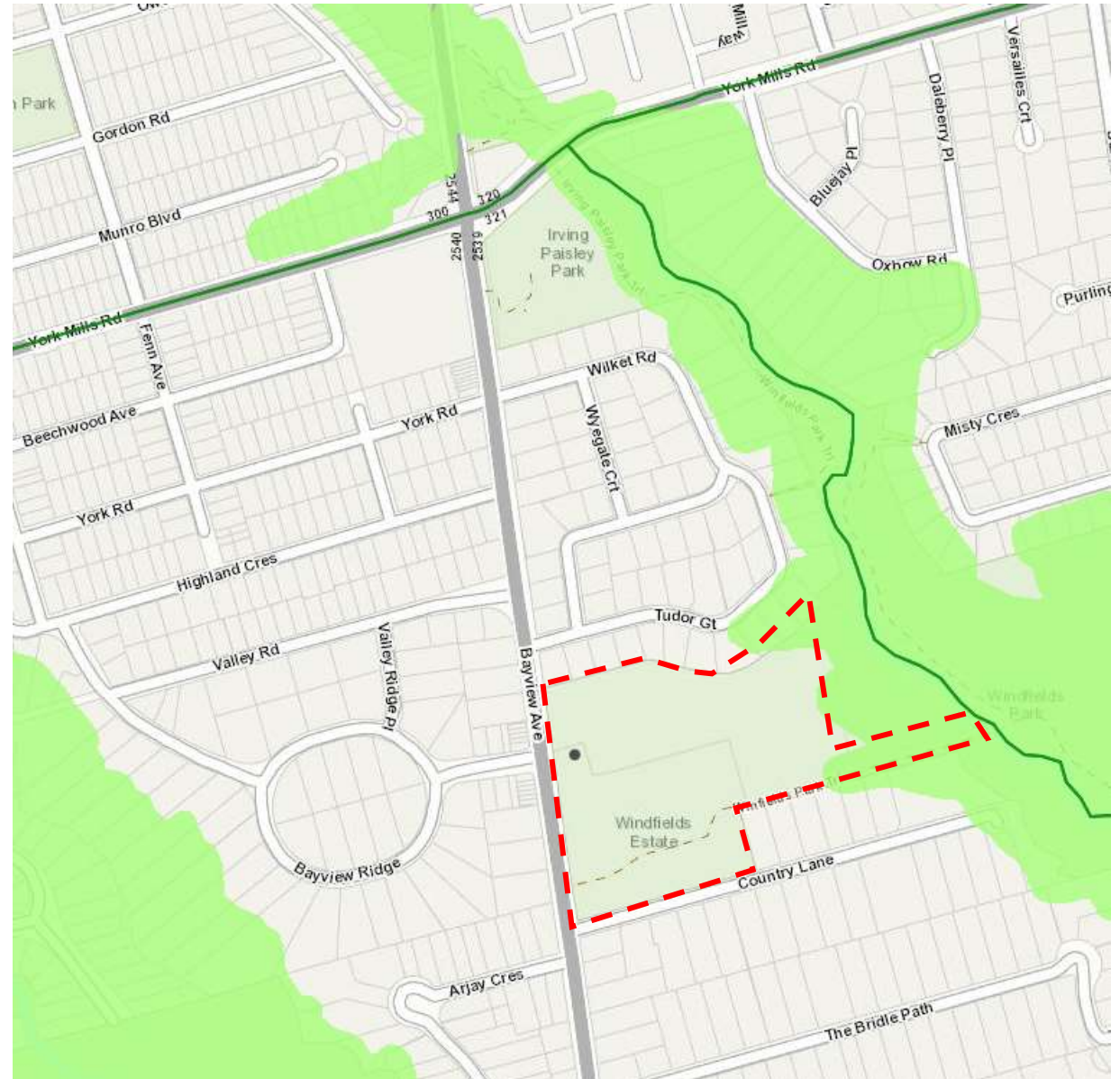

These location maps are for information purposes only; the exact boundaries of the property are not shown. The red, dashed line marks the location of the site.



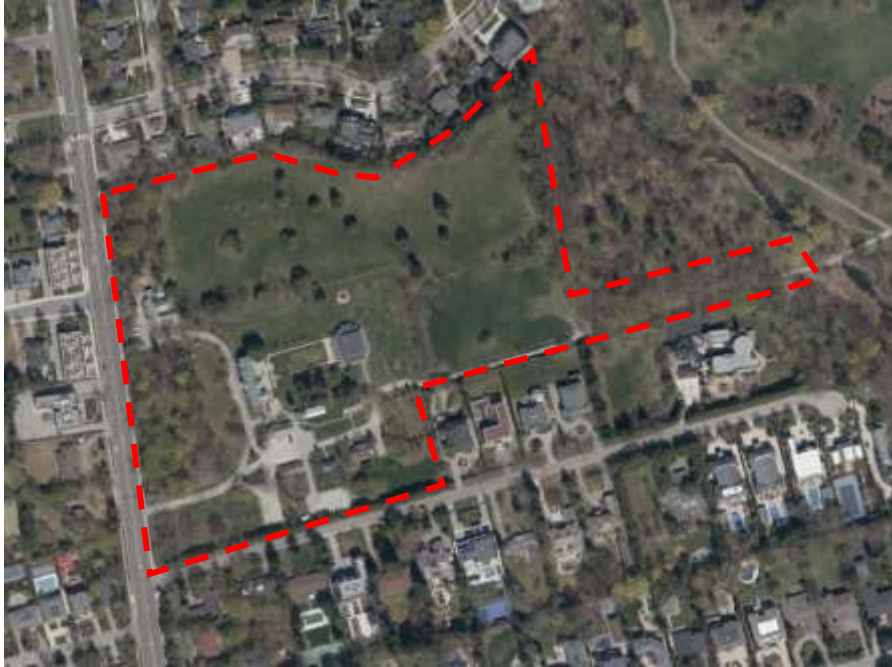

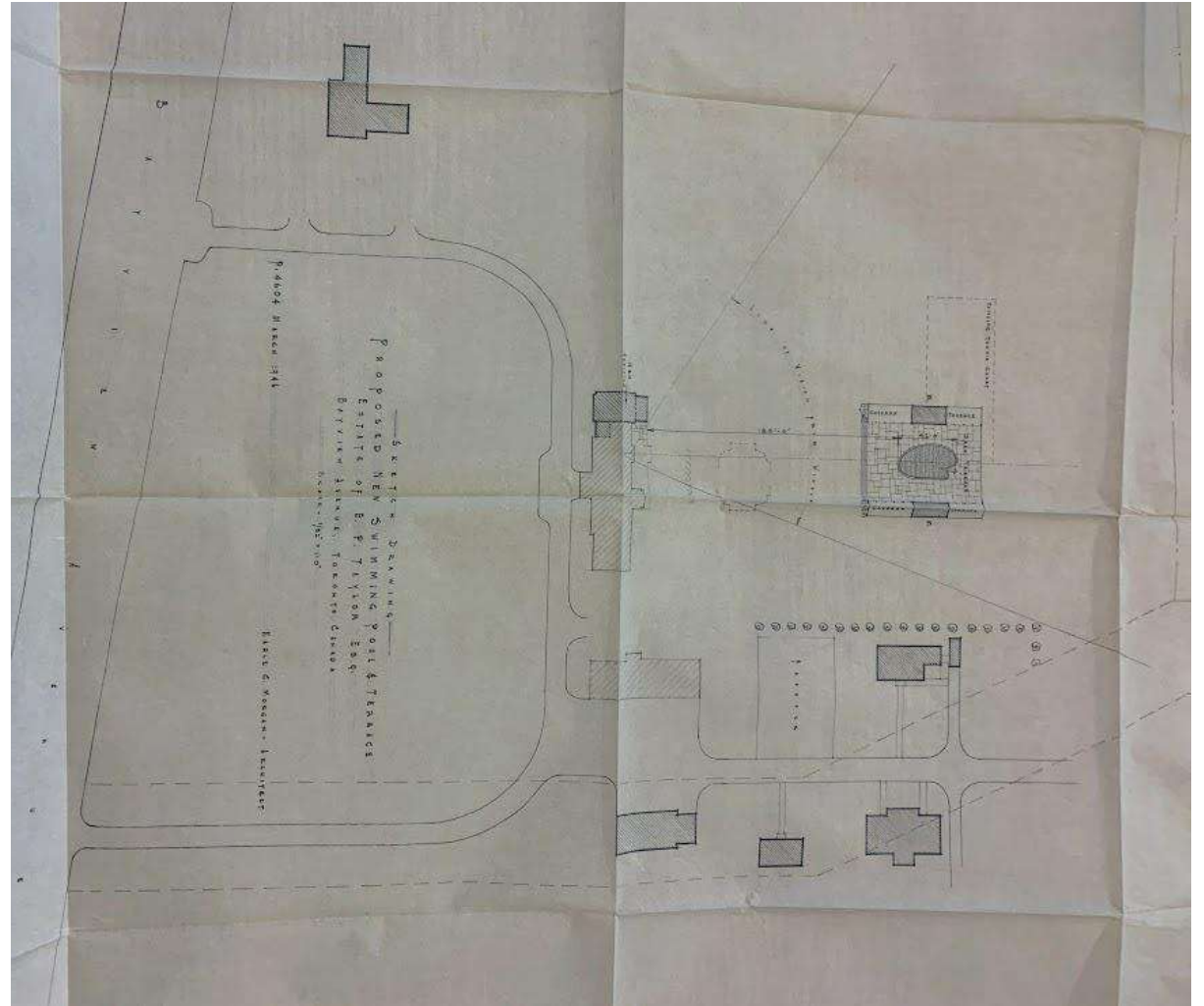

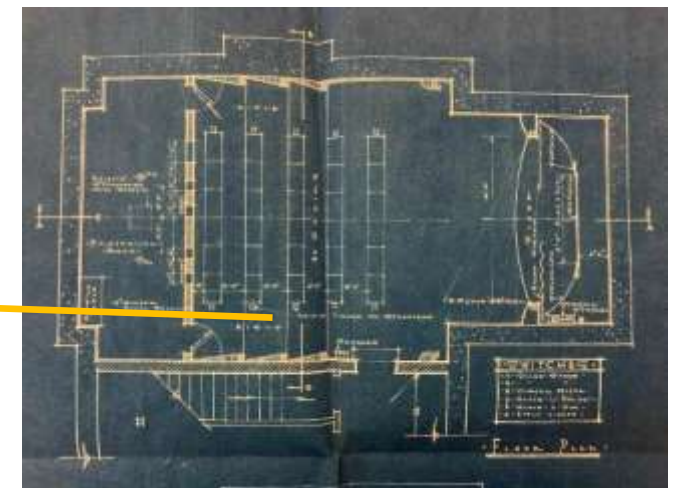
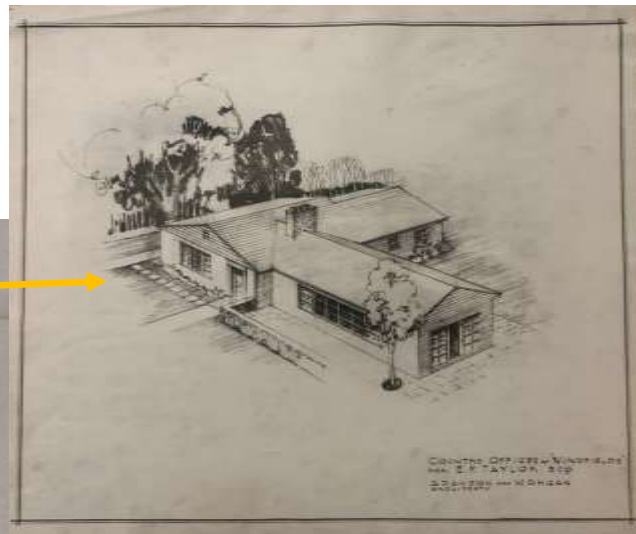
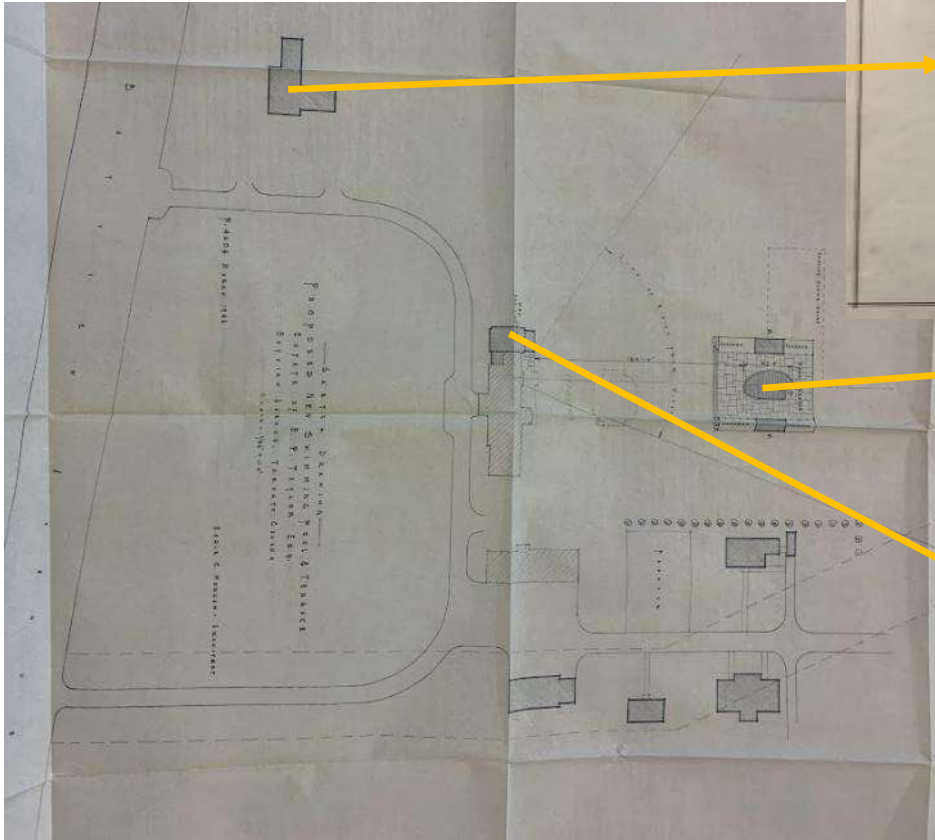

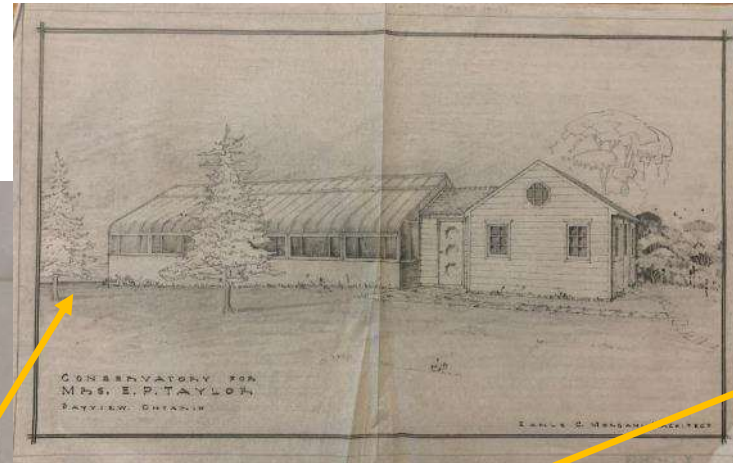
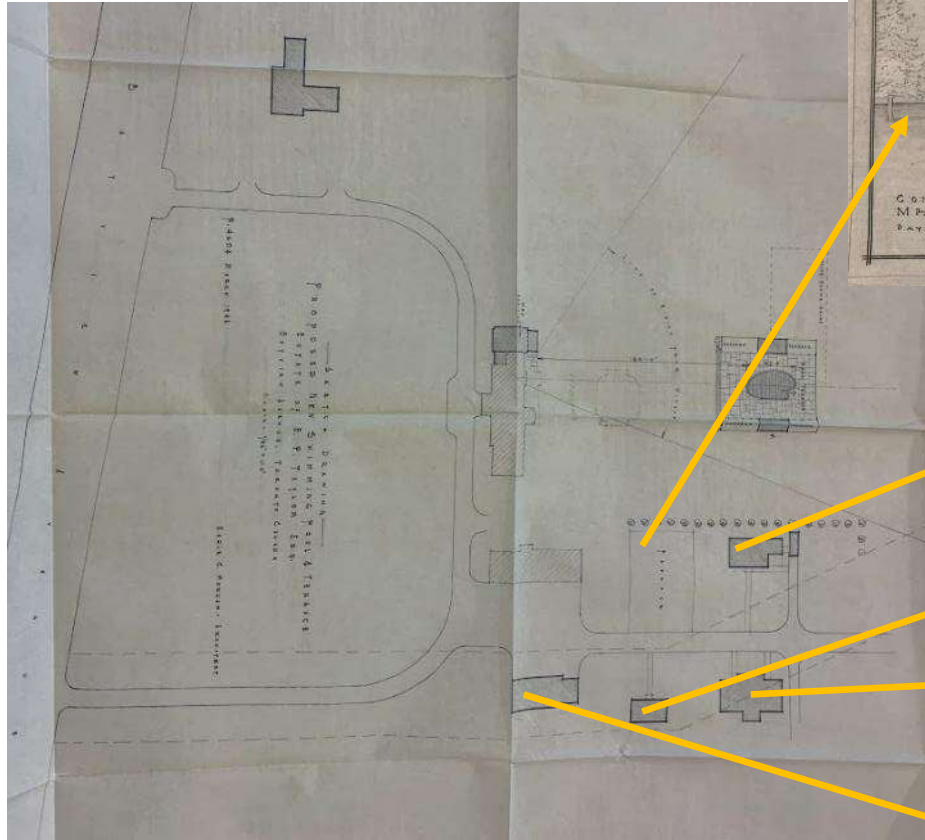


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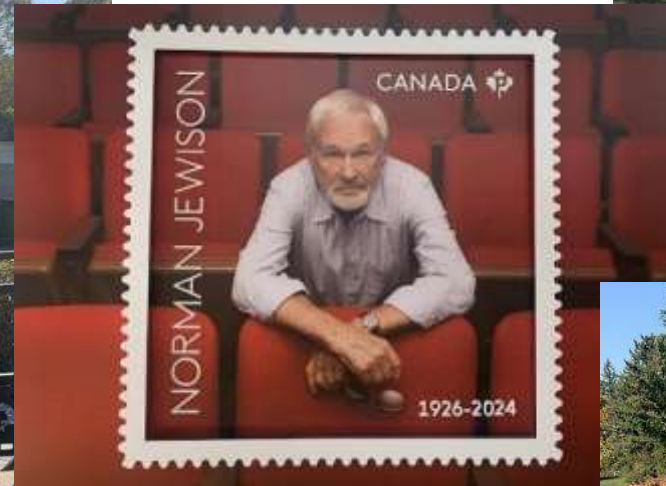
1946-1952: The Gatehouse, Pool & Cabanas, and a private movie theatre in the basement of a new North Wing on the Main House.
