## Position on Official Plan and Zoning By-Law Amendment Application

On behalf of More Neighbours Toronto, I am excited to express our strong support for the Zoning By-law amendment that will enable the development of 78 new affordable rent-geared-to-income units at 35 Bellevue Avenue in Kensington Market. The speed at which this project is moving forward is a fantastic example of how quickly we can create solutions to address Toronto's housing crisis, and we are hopeful that this approach can be replicated many times over with the help of provincial and federal funding.

While 78 units is a significant achievement, the housing need in Toronto is immense, and this project sets a powerful precedent for future developments. The swift approval and the goal to begin construction by the end of 2024 reflect the City's strong commitment to providing affordable housing, and we are eager to see more projects follow suit.

Located in the heart of vibrant Kensington Market, and along two major streetcar routes, this development will not only offer much-needed affordable homes but also provide residents with excellent access to transit and local amenities.
