Phase 2:

Determining Top 3 Priorities

- **Gap analysis.** Based on the presentations the Committee will determine where it can make the biggest impact in line with its mandate.
- **Work plan.** The committee will then vote to determine the top 3 priorities which will make up its work plan.

Phase 3:

Implementing, Tracking and Evaluating

- **Advise.** Based on the priorities identified for the work plan, selected divisions will be invited to the committee to engage in a working session to determine opportunities to strengthen and improve City policies, programs and services.
- **Share.** A divisional report back schedule will be developed.
- **Measure.** Program staff will track and report on progress
