The Mayor and Members of Toronto City Council are deeply saddened to learn of the passing of John Alfred (Jack) Fenn on Sunday, January 28, 2024, at the age of 88.

Jack was the loving spouse of Lorna (Monkman) Fenn for over 64 years, and the loving father to Kevin, Lisa, Sharon, and Robert. He was a proud grandfather to Ryan, Scott, Braden, Kyle, and Brooklynn, and fortunate to have been a great-grandfather to Hailey, Hunter, Hayden, Cooper, and Taylor. Jack's love and support will be missed by his entire family.

A longtime resident of Willowdale, Jack was born and raised in Toronto, and attended St. Michael's College School and the University of St. Michael's College at the University of Toronto.

After graduation, Jack returned to St. Michael's College School to begin his 35-year teaching career. Geography was his teaching specialty and he coached football for 25 years. For the last seven years of his career Jack served as vice-principal.

Over 10,000 young men have been taught, coached and counselled by Jack Fenn and the verdict is virtually unanimous from them all - he was honest, fair, demanding and loyal to everyone who came into contact with him. For his years of concern and toil both in the classroom and on the football field, and his tireless support for the young men of the St. Michael's community, he was awarded the Order of St. Michael.

Aside from Jack's service in his community in Toronto, he also volunteered in many organizations in the Township of Muskoka Lakes. One of his first volunteer projects was being on the committee for the restoration of St. Anne's Church on Fenn's Point.
