Martin was a dedicated employee of the City of Toronto for over 38 years, having joined the City in 1979 and worked until his retirement in 2018. Martin spent all those years as a leader in the capital markets group advising the Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer, along with eight different mayors, on both municipal investment and debt management. During that time, Martin provided prudent advice and guided the City through several economic cycles and global financial crises during his tenure.

Martin's efforts and legacy provided the lowest cost of capital for a growing city looking to finance its capital projects that are still in use today and will leave an impact on residents for many years to come.
