The Mayor and Members of Toronto City Council are saddened to learn of the passing of Jeffery Charles Elon Sinclair on May 23, 2024, at the age of 43.

Jeffery was born on September 29, 1980, to Elon Tobyia Sinclair and Isolyn Victoria (Smith) in Toronto, Ontario, Canada. He was the last of three children and the beloved baby brother to Antoinette (Sinclair) and Nicole Sinclair (Anderson). In 2010, Jeffery met and fell in love with Nicole Bridgette Greaves and they married on October 28, 2011. In 2013 they welcomed their precious daughter Eliana Evelyn Sinclair. Jeffery and Nicole established their home in Scarborough, Ontario where they raised their daughter.

Jeffery's Christian upbringing at the 48 Fisher Street First Seventh-Day Baptist Church, established his vigorous pursuit of truth and was instrumental in establishing the faith that would remain with him until his dying breath. Jeffery was determined that everyone he met would come to know the gospel. Throughout his life, Jeffery would lead multiple bible studies which left a lasting impact on many.
