
#### No More Noise Toronto

#### What noise sources disturb us




#### What I've heard

- We've had dialogues with ML&S, TPS, CXD and TPH heard us loud and clear this Spring.
- City Processes
  - Old software
  - Silos
- CXD
  - Implementation of Salesforce
- MLS:
  - Noise most complex and complicated bylaws to enforce 10% of workload
  - Don't have manpower to properly address some noise issues moving vehicles
- TPS:
  - Doesn't have the resources to reduce moving vehicle noise.
  - Recommends automated enforcement


Report – Updates – Timely Resolution Understand the Process

- Took too long
- Discouraged from reporting by staff
- Not treated with respect
- Made to feel like it is "my fault"
- Didn't have all info
- Didn't think anything would change
- Wanted to be anonymous
- Didn't know what the process was





## **Constituent Experience**

#### **Enforcing Noise Bylaws**


- Not in time
- Took too long to schedule
- Unclear process for measurement
- Invasive evening visits in a home
- Uncomfortable,
- Nothing changed
- Bylaw not enforced





#### Recommendations

- Create separate workflow for noise
- Improve processes,
  - Make reporting easy
  - Anonymous with disclaimer
  - Standard tracking number
  - Automate text parsing, comms
- Reduce the number of reports
  - Area sound level monitoring
  - Automated noise enforcement
  - Manage noise to protect health
