

## **Council Member Appointment to Fill a Vacancy on the Service Excellence Committee**

### **SUMMARY**

The purpose of this report is to recommend to City Council the appointment of a Council Member to fill a vacancy on the Service Excellence Committee, resulting from the resignation of Councillor Jaye Robinson from the Committee.

The City Clerk recommends that:

1. The Striking Committee consider Members' preferences and recommend to City Council the appointment of one Council Member to the Service Excellence Committee, for a term of office until December 31, 2024, and until a successor is appointed.

### **DECISION HISTORY**

---

City Council, at its meeting on October 11 and 12, 2023, appointed Members of Council to the Service Excellence Committee, having regard that Mayor Olivia Chow had already appointed Councillor Stephen Holyday as Chair and Councillor Paul Ainslie as Vice-Chair.
