Colleagues from Pembina Institute, led by Jennifer Meneses, Associate Director, Strategic Partnerships, will provide an update on their TAF-funded work to develop a national zero emissions medium- and heavy-duty vehicle strategy.

DECISION HISTORY

On November 5, 2021, the TAF Board approved a grant of \$150,000 over 18 months to Pembina Institute to develop a national zero emissions medium- and heavy-duty vehicle (MHDV) strategy, outlining priority actions and policy changes needed to achieve 100 percent zero emissions MHDV sales by 2040.
