**Re: Traffic Calming – Currie Avenue, between Hillingdon Avenue and Coxwell Avenue**

**BACKGROUND:**

Earl Haig Public School reached out to my office with concerns about road safety in their community. As the majority of residents surrounding the school are in favour of this safety initiative, I would like to recommend the installation of speed humps along Currie Ave, between Hillingdon Ave and Coxwell Ave.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council authorize the installation of traffic calming (speed humps) on Currie Avenue, between Hillingdon Avenue and Coxwell Avenue.
2. Toronto and East York Community Council direct the City Solicitor to prepare a by-law to alter the roadway to install three speed humps on Currie Avenue, between Hillingdon Avenue and Coxwell Avenue, generally as shown on the attached Drawing No. TC-230, dated January 2024 from the Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services.
