Shaftesbury Avenue: Recommended Traffic Flow Modifications

Dear Councillor Saxe:

It is the view of the *Summerhill Residents Association* ("SRA") that - following opening of the new TTC subway station entrance - the traffic flow on Shaftesbury Avenue needs to be re-directed, as follows:

- 1. It is the preference of the SRA that the current one-way easterly flow around the enclosed TTC construction staging area be replaced with appropriately signalized staggered two-way traffic flows.
- 2. In the absence of adequate spatial standards to accommodate a twoway traffic flow, the SRA recommends that the current one-way easterly traffic flow be reversed to a one-way westerly traffic flow.

These two proposed alternatives seek to address two safety issues:

- Our landlocked neighbourhood has no signalized exit onto Yonge Street at Summerhill Avenue where southbound vehicular traffic needs to cross both a bicycle lane and a frequently congested traffic lane; and
- Pedestrians exiting the new subway station entrance cannot see oncoming easterly traffic to safely cross Shaftesbury Avenue and reach the southerly sidewalk.

The SRA very much appreciates your attention to this matter.
