

Temporary Adjustments to Parking Regulations and the Extension of Permit Parking Hours - 2024 Distillery Winter Village (Delegated)

SUMMARY

This staff report concerns a matter for which the Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is recommending temporary parking amendments on streets in the vicinity of the Distillery District to enhance traffic operations and pedestrian safety during the annual Distillery Winter Village, which takes place from November 13, 2024 to January 5, 2025, inclusive.

A companion report "Temporary Adjustments to Traffic and Parking Regulations for 2024 Distillery Winter Village (Non-delegated)" outlines the required non-delegated temporary traffic and parking amendments for streets with Toronto Transit Commission (TTC) Service.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Director, Permits and Enforcement, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council authorize the temporary parking regulations on streets in the vicinity of Distillery District that are impacted during the Distillery Winter Village, identified in Attachment 2 attached to the report dated September 26, 2024 from the Director, Permits and Enforcement, Transportation Services, subject to City Council adoption of the companion report entitled "Temporary Adjustments to Traffic and Parking Regulations for 2024 Distillery Winter Village (Non-delegated)". The temporary parking regulations will override all existing regulations for the duration of this event (November 13, 2024 to January 5, 2025).
2. Toronto and East York Community Council direct Transportation staff to communicate this temporary extension of 24 hour permit parking on the streets outlined Temporary Adjustments to Parking Regulations for 2024 Winter Village (Delegated)

in Recommendation 1 above to residents through a targeted information campaign throughout the duration of the Distillery Winter Village.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The event organizers will be responsible for the full costs associated with the Distillery Winter Village event.

The signage costs associated with the proposed temporary amendments are approximately \$800. Funding is available within the Transportation Services 2024 Operating Budget.

Toronto and East York Community Council at its meeting of October 18, 2023, by adoption of TE8.31 authorized the temporary parking regulations on streets in the vicinity of Distillery District that are impacted during the Distillery Winter Village.

COMMENTS

Due to the high volume of vehicular and pedestrian traffic generated during the Distillery Winter Village, Transportation Services is proposing temporary parking regulation amendments on various streets within the vicinity of the Distillery District, as shown in Attachment 1. Similar to previous years, these changes will help to maintain efficient traffic conditions in the general area while ensuring that local residents have minimal impact by removing on-street parking in the Distillery District area and providing designated parking zones for local residents and taxi stands.

Upon completion of the event, Transportation Services staff, in consultation with the local Councillors, the event organizers and other stakeholders will evaluate the traffic management plan. In this regard amendments to the traffic management plan may be implemented for the following year.

The local Ward Councillors have been advised of the recommendations of this staff report.

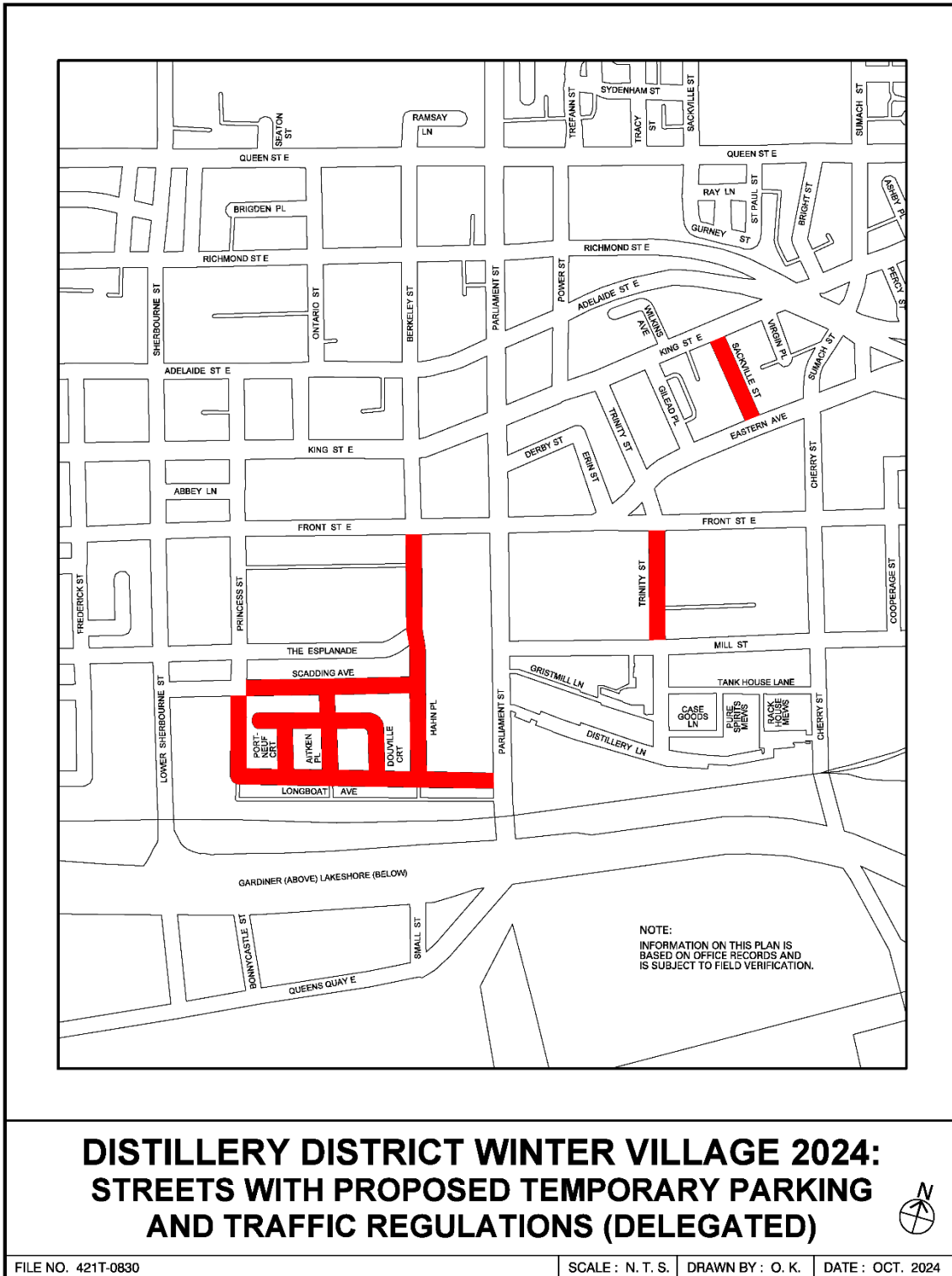
