Re: Speed Hump Installation – Devonshire Place between Bloor Street West and Hoskin Avenue

Dear Toronto and East York Community Council members:

SUMMARY:

The purpose of this motion is to seek City Council approval for the installation of traffic calming measures (speed humps) on Devonshire Place, between Bloor Street West and Hoskin Avenue. The speed humps are intended to slow vehicles down on Devonshire Place where there is heavy pedestrian traffic generated by University of Toronto as well as other learning institutions in the area, and have been requested by the University.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council authorize the installation of traffic calming (speed humps) on Devonshire Place, between Bloor Street West and Hoskin Avenue.
2. Toronto and East York Community Council direct the City Solicitor to prepare a by-law to alter the roadway to install five speed humps on Devonshire Place, between Bloor Street West and Hoskin Avenue, generally as shown on the attached Drawing No. TC-425, dated November 2024 from the Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services.
