For the provision of construction services related to the restoration of an exposed sanitary sewer crossing on Humber Creek within Chapman Valley Park (Phase 2).

\$4,995,182 net of all applicable taxes and charges

\$5,644,556 including HST and all applicable charges

\$5,083,097 net of HST recoveries

Contract is expected to start on date of award and end on December 31, 2026.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total contract award identified in this report is \$5,644,556 including all applicable taxes and charges. The cost to the City is \$5,083,097 net of HST recoveries.

The engineering estimate for this project is \$6,885,156 net of all taxes and charges.

Funding for this contract award is included in the 2025 Capital Budgets and the 2026 - 2034 Capital Plans for Toronto Water and Transportation Services. Funding details are summarized as follows:
