\$1,279,303 net of HST recoveries

Contract is expected to start on date of award and end on December 31, 2025.

### FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total contract award identified in this report is \$1,420,610 including all applicable taxes and charges. The cost to the City is \$1,279,303 net of HST recoveries.

The engineering estimate for this project is \$1,742,186 net of all taxes and charges.

Funding is included in the 2025 Capital Budget and 2026-2034 Capital Plan for Transportation Services. Funding details are summarized as follows:
