SUMMARY

Attached is the Annual Report of the Toronto Lobbyist Registrar for the Year 2024.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Lobbyist Registrar recommends that:

1. City Council request the Lobbyist Registrar, in consultation with the City Manager and the City Solicitor, report back to Executive Committee in Q4, 2025, on a potential amendment to the Lobbying By-law to clarify how it applies to participation in City-established roundtables, working groups, and advisory bodies.
2. City Council receive the Annual Report of the Toronto Lobbyist Registrar for the Year 2024 for information.

DECISION HISTORY

The Toronto Municipal Code, Accountability Officers, s.3-1.6 provides that an accountability officer shall report annually to Council on the activities of his or her office and the discharge of his or her duties.

The City of Toronto Act, 2006, section 168 authorized the City to appoint a Registrar who is responsible for performing in an independent manner, the functions assigned by City Council with respect to the Registry described in subsection 165 (1) and the system of registration and other matters described in section 166.
