REASON FOR CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

This report contains advice or communications that are subject to solicitor-client privilege. This report contains information regarding potential litigation.

SUMMARY

On April 10, 2025, the applicant submitted Minor Variance applications for 155 Thirtieth Street and 157 Thirtieth Street (the "Sites") seeking a variance to the City-wide Zoning By-law 569-2013 in order to permit a personal service shop use on the Sites.

The City appealed the Committee of Adjustment's decisions to approve the applications for the Minor Variance (the "Appeal"), to the Toronto Local Appeal Body (the "TLAB") on June 4, 2025.

The City Solicitor requires further directions for an upcoming TLAB Hearing scheduled for November 24, 2025. The matter is urgent and cannot be deferred.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The City Solicitor recommends that:

- 1. City Council adopt the recommendations contained in Confidential Attachment 1 to this report from the City Solicitor.
- 2. City Council authorize the public release of the confidential recommendations contained in Confidential Attachment 1 to this report from the City Solicitor, if adopted by City Council.

3. City Council direct that all other information contained in Confidential Attachment 1 to this report from the City Solicitor is to remain confidential at the discretion of the City Solicitor, as it contains advice which is subject to solicitor-client privilege.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no financial impact arising from the adoption of the Confidential Recommendations beyond what has already been approved in the current year's budget.

DECISION HISTORY

At its meeting held on August 25, 26, 27 and 28, 2014, City Council adopted Item ED33.9, which provided standing direction to the City Solicitor and appropriate City staff to appeal decisions of the Committee of Adjustment which do not conform with the Official Plan's Employment Areas policies. On April 10, 2025, the applicant submitted Minor Variance applications seeking a variance to the City-wide Zoning By-law 569-2013 in order to permit a personal service shop use at 155 Thirtieth Street and 157 Thirtieth Street. The Sites are zoned under Zoning By-law 569-2013 as Employment Industrial and are designated as a *Core Employment Area* in the City of Toronto Official Plan.

On May 15, 2025, the Etobicoke York Panel of the Committee of Adjustment approved the applications.

On June 4, 2025, the City Solicitor appealed the Committee of Adjustment's decisions on the applications to the TLAB on behalf of the City under the direction of City Council Item ED33.9.

A TLAB hearing is scheduled for November 24, 2025.
