PH18.5 - Housing Action Plan: Avenues Policy Review - Decision Report

Dear Mayor Chow and Members of the City Council,

On behalf of the East Waterfront Community Association (EWCA), I am writing to express our concerns regarding the Avenues Policy Review report and to support the positions of FoSTRA and FoNTRA in delaying any decision on this matter. EWCA is a founding member of FoSTRA and through its Affordable Housing Team is affiliated with the Federation of North Toronto Residents' Associations (FoNTRA).

Our key concerns regarding this report for decision include:

- 1. Scope and Scale: The proposal represents a 165% increase in Avenue lands, affecting 283 kilometres of streets, with minimal detail on key policy features, creating concern and confusion in communities.
- 2. Lack of Specificity: The report recommends large-scale changes without providing a clear work plan for implementation or defining crucial terms like "where appropriate" and "higher" building heights.
- 3. Insufficient Public Consultation: Given the complexity and far-reaching implications of the proposal, more time is needed for public engagement and understanding.

We recommend:

- 1. Given the complexity of the proposal, that staff provide ways to improve the communication and engagement of the public as the study enters Phase 2
- 2. Holding the report until a Phase 2 work plan is submitted, including a communications and public consultation strategy.
- 3. Establishing clear height limits, gradual transitions, and protections for surrounding residential neighbourhoods before approving changes.

We urge the committee to consider these points and delay decision-making to allow for more detailed planning and community input.
