## 122 Communications were received with text similar to the following:

Dear IEC,

No new bike lanes.

I fully understand that the City of Toronto is facing unprecedented challenges with Bill 212, which restricts how and where Ontario municipalities can build bike lanes that involve removing travel lanes. I want to commend you and your colleagues for your firm opposition to that legislation back in November. (1)

But the city's 2025.IE23.6 Cycling Network Plan – Second Quarter Update<sup>(2)</sup> puts forward zero new kilometres of bike lanes.

This moment calls for leadership, not retreat.

Today I am asking you to:

- 1. Complete the Leaside Bridge to Danforth Avenue Cycling Connections, and move forward installing the Logan-Carlaw contraflow bike lanes;
- Make Jones safer for all road users, and reject the staff recommendations to reverse Council's decision on upgrading the existing painted bike lanes to protected cycle tracks;
- 3. Direct staff to expedite public consultations on all the major projects in the Council-approved 2025-2027 Cycling Network Plan<sup>(3)</sup> that don't necessarily involve lane removals or whose delivery notes indicate "dependent on bundled or sequenced work (transit, road, water, other)" including:
  - Brimorton Drive Major Upgrade
  - Danforth-Kingston (Kingston sections)
  - Eglinton Avenue East
  - Greenwood Major Upgrade
  - Jane and Finch Connections
  - Keele Street
  - Kipling North
- 4. Direct staff to bring forward a plan for 2026 to upgrade the existing cycling network including filling potholes in bike lanes<sup>(4)</sup> and replacing all quick build materials (pinned curbs, low walls, flexi-posts, etc) to permanent materials like poured concrete to enhance their comfort and beauty<sup>(5)</sup>

Not moving forward with contraflow bike lanes on Logan-Carlaw or reversing the Council-approved decision to upgrade bike lanes on Jones cannot be blamed on provincial overreach. No travel lanes are impacted. Logan-Carlaw even meets the premier's own criteria of putting "bike lanes on secondary roads" by avoiding parallel arterials.

You have the power to keep building a healthier and more vibrant cycling city for everyone.
