REASON FOR CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

This report is about labour relations or employee negotiations.

SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to seek Board approval for a bargaining mandate with IATSE Local 58 at the St. Lawrence Centre.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The President and Chief Executive recommends that the Board of Directors of TO Live:

1. Approve the bargaining mandate with IATSE Local 58 at the St. Lawrence Centre, as noted in Confidential Attachment 1.
2. Direct that the confidential information contained in Confidential Attachment 1 remain confidential in its entirety, as it contains labour relations information or employee negotiations.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no financial impact other than those outlined in Confidential Attachment 1.

DECISION HISTORY

At its February 15, 2023, meeting, the Board of Directors approved the negotiated terms of the collective bargaining agreement with IATSE Local 58 at the St. Lawrence Centre.

COMMENTS

IATSE Local 58 provides stage labour services at the St. Lawrence Centre where, in addition to house positions, the Local works as a Hiring Hall. There is one house position in the Jane Mallet Theatre and four house positions in the Bluma Appel Theatre. There are guarantees of sixty-three (63) half-weeks, of twenty (20) hours each, for each house position.

The current agreement expired on December 31, 2024 and negotiations can begin immediately with Board approval.
