From time to time, it is necessary to remove Business Improvement Area (BIA) Board of Management directors who are no longer able to serve, and add new directors to fill vacant positions, as set out in Chapter 19 of the Toronto Municipal Code. Council members are appointed by right-of-office to the boards of BIAs in their wards.

Rogers Road

The appointment of one (1) director to the Rogers Road BIA Board of Management will decrease the number of vacancies on the board from three (3) to two (2). Quorum will remain at three (3).
