Changes

Through operational changes and should City Council adopt staff report recommendations, Municipal Licensing and Standards Division will amend in 2026 the licence application requirements to:

- 1. One piece of government ID showing the applicant's name, photo, and age
- 2. A second piece of government ID showing proof of work status (except for corporation applicants)
- 3. Criminal and judicial matters check (level 2)
- 4. Recent photo of applicant (can be a mobile photo)

From business establishment licence applicants only (i.e., not trade or driver/vehicle owner licences), Municipal Licensing and Standards will continue to require:

5. An occupancy declaration form

From corporation applicants only, Municipal Licensing and Standards will continue to require:

- 6. Articles of incorporation
- 7. Annual return (i.e., list of all directors, officers, and shareholders)
- 8. Signing authority on corporate letterhead (if designate of a corporation is applying)

From applicants for certain business establishment licences or professions, Municipal Licensing and Standards may also require any of the following:

- 9. Zoning clearance
- 10. Approvals from other regulatory bodies (e.g., Ministry of Transportation safety standards certification; Technical Standards and Safety Authority inspection; Canada Revenue Agency confirmation of registered charity status; etc.)
- 11. Proof of liability insurance
- 12. Photos of vehicle or floor plans of the establishment
- 13. Patron management plan
- 14. Noise control plan

Current state

To obtain a business licence, applicants must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards the following:

- 1. One piece of government ID showing the applicant's name, photo, and age
- 2. A second piece of government ID showing proof of work status (except for corporation applicants)
- 3. Criminal and judicial matters check (level 2)
- 4. Recent photo of applicant (can be a mobile photo)

From business establishment licence applicants only (i.e., not trade or driver/vehicle owner licences), Municipal Licensing and Standards will continue to require:

From corporation applicants only, Municipal Licensing and Standards will continue to require:

- 12. Proof of liability insurance
- 13. Proof of health and safety declaration (e.g., Workplace Safety and Insurance Board insurance)
- 14. Photos of vehicle or floor plans of the establishment
- 15. Patron management plan
- 16. Noise control plan
- 17. List of employees
- 18. Letter from an employer
- 19. List of products and services sold
- 20. Physician's certificate of medical fitness indicating that the applicant or licensee is free from communicable diseases
