RE: EC19.5 - Addressing Dangerous Dogs - Response to 2024.EC16.3

To Economic and Community Development Committee:

Established in Thorncliffe Park in the 1980s, the Leaside Towers Tenants Association (LTTA) is a volunteer, resident-led group that represents the 2,500 Torontonians residing at 85 and 95 Thorncliffe Park Drive on concerns relating to their rental apartment tenancies, as well as matters of broader importance to the Thorncliffe Park community.

In addition to the recommendations from the Executive Director, Municipal Licensing and Standards, the LTTA requests the following amendment to be considered with EC19.5:

City Council amend Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 354, Apartment Buildings to amend 354-3.2. Tenant notification procedures to include that a warning sign is posted on the tenant notification board in a manner that ensures dangerous dog information is completely visible to tenants.
