We strongly oppose the proposed development and the City of Toronto's decision to demolish an existing ice surface when there is already a shortage of available ice across the city.

Equally concerning is the manner in which this process has unfolded — without meaningful community consultation or transparent dialogue with those who rely on this rink.

We urge the City to terminate its discussions with MLSE regarding this proposal and to ensure that this historic ice surface remains available to the community that has supported and sustained it for decades.

If this is not possible, we respectfully request that all participants of the Weston Lions Hockey programs be provided with a suitable and comparable ice surface to continue their activities without disruption.
