Re: Glen Scarlett Road Speed Limit Increase – Motion Memorandum

Transportation Services has been requested by a local councillor to provide recommended wording for recommendations they plan to present in a motion to Etobicoke York Community Council. Staff request that this memorandum accompany the member's submission.

Summary

Staff do not have sufficient data and/or time to determine if the draft recommendations provided below can be supported by staff, at this time.

Draft Recommendations

1. Etobicoke York Community Council amend the existing speed limit from 30 km/h to 40 km/h on Glen Scarlett Road, between Gunns Road and Symes Road
2. Etobicoke York Community Council authorize the amendment of Schedule XLV (Part 1) to City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, to add Glen Scarlett Road, between Gunns Road and Symes Road, to be omitted from the Designated Area such that this portion of highway will then be excluded from the corresponding designated area in Column 1 in Schedule XLV (Part 1).

The Ward Councillor received a request from the commercial businesses on Glen Scarlett Road to have the 30 km/h speed limit increased to 40 km/h. The 30 km/h speed limit reduction on all local roads in Ward 5 was introduced under the Vision Zero Road Safety Plan in 2021.

Cost

Staff have not been able to develop engineering estimates for this work but based on previous experience and similar work in the past, we expect the costs associated with

approving the draft recommendations below will be approximately \$1000. As this work was not anticipated, it has not been specifically included in any approved budgets. Completion of the work would be subject to availability and competing priorities within future Transportation Services Operating Budgets, unless a specific funding source is identified by the councillor and approved by Etobicoke York Community Council
