# ➤ Child Care Oversight

## **Provincial Framework for Infection Prevention and Control (IPAC) Oversight in CCCs**

- IPAC Protocol: Requires annual IPAC inspections
- IPAC Disclosure Protocol: Requires public disclosure of inspection results on TPH's website

## **TPH Actions Supporting Framework**

- Public Health Inspectors (PHIs) conduct annual IPAC inspections
- Respond to complaints, offer education to operators/staff & consultations on IPAC best practices
- New - Starting January 1st - Publicly disclose IPAC inspection results

# ➤ TPH IPAC Inspection Process

## Inspection Frequency

- CCCs are inspected at a minimum once per year
- Re-inspections are conducted within 48 hours (based on severity)
- Additional inspections associated with outbreaks and complaints

## Documentation and Reporting

- PHIs provide written directions for corrective actions
- Inspection Outcomes: Satisfactory, Re-inspection Required, Closed



# ➤ **Inspection Outcomes for Child Care Centres**

## **Child Care Centres have high rates of compliance:**

- IPAC inspection pass rates have increased to 96% post-pandemic with 99% of all CCCs inspected.

## **Regularly observed deficiencies are usually minor and simple to address:**

- Failure to post current Information sheets
- Failure to post information sheets in appropriate areas
- Failure to maintain floors, walls, or maintaining equipment in a sanitary condition
