Attachment 3: Additional Costs for Eight (8) Electric Litter Vacuums in the West

To align with the City's decarbonization goals, staff explored possibilities of including electric litter vacuums into the operation. Due to the current yards infrastructure not being able to support the electrical capacity required for electric litter vacuums at all yards, it was identified that the West could support eight (8) electric litter vacuums with some upgrades. Table 1 outlines the additional costs associated with having eight (8) electric litter vacuums in the West.
