Dear Allen and Nicole:

Re: The Necessity of Supplemental Recycling Collection for Households Impacted by Route Optimization for January 2026 on Account of the Transition of the Blue Box Program to Extended Producer Responsibility

Thank you for your letter dated November 7, 2025, in response to the City of Toronto's letter (dated October 31, 2025) regarding supplemental recycling collection, as required, for a portion of households in Districts 2 and 3 in January 2026.

The City appreciates Circular Materials' commitment to providing supplemental recycling collection on January 2 – 3, 2026 to 26,303 impacted residences in Districts 2 and 3, per your letter. However, City staff are concerned with Circular Materials' plan to provide the first recycling collection on Monday January 5, 2026, for 31,496 residences in Districts 2 and 3. While we applaud your efforts to ensure impacted households do not wait more than 2 weeks between recycling collections, undertaking this collection on a Monday is a tremendous concern. The City has not provided curbside collection on a Monday in many years and this action will add confusion for residents at a critical juncture in the post-transition phase where Circular Materials' contractor takes over collection of Blue Box Materials from eligible sources. Furthermore, for residents that call for a missed collection between Tuesday January 6, 2026 – Friday January 12, 2026, and are told they should have put their recycling bin out on Monday January 5, 2026, resident frustration will increase rapidly, not leaving residents with a good first impression of the new recycling system.

Both the City and Circular Materials are profoundly committed to ensuring a smooth transition for all residents. To ensure this comes to fruition, and based on the City's extensive



operational experience, I recommend Circular Materials does not collect recycling from these residences on Monday January 5, 2026, but rather provides the supplemental collection during overtime hours between Tuesday January 6, 2026 and Friday January 9, 2026, as required. Communications will be simple and clear that residents are to leave their recycling bin at the curb until it has been collected between Tuesday January 6, 2026 and Friday January 9, 2026.

<u>Please respond by end of day Friday November 14, 2025, to advise if Circular Materials is amenable to this revised supplemental collection approach.</u>
