The Damage Was Done

S.A.D.R.A Park Trail, Ward 9 Davenport

We would like to thank the new interim Director for bringing this report forward to the Infrastructure and Environment Committee. We welcome this opportunity to comment on the report and share our experience as well as propose repairs. We've included an infographic below as well as photos taken today to demonstrate some of the extent of the damage. S.A.D.R.A park is a 350m pedestrian trail with many amenities including a POPS splash pad, climbing playground with swings and sand pit, concrete ball hockey pad and adult calisthenics gym.



Bins in the SADRA walking trail :

-Accessible by Old Weston, Silverthorn, Blackthorn are one mixed use bin for each location, respectively.

-East side of Silverthorn Ave is a pair of bins (green/blue)

-Inside the interior of the trail, between Old Weston and Silverthorn in a 75m section, accessible by Cloverdale Road with direct access to the park, there are 6 bins (3 green, 3 blue).

In total there are 11 bins to be emptied within a 350m stretch.

We ask the Director and Committee to remove the 4 superfluous bins East of Old Weston. We ask them to keep the mixed use bins (blue rectangles) accessible by the Avenues and the pair of recycling and compost bins (one green star) at the Playground which is accessible by Cloverdale Road and the pair on the East side of Silverthorn Ave at the Ball Hockey Pad. We believe that these will more than serve the community's needs, while eliminate the need for waste vehicles to enter the park.

We also ask that rehabilitation of SADRA walking trail be a high priority. There are several amenities in this path and although cooler weather is on its way, this path remains a major pedestrian pathway of pet owners, commuters and parents alike.

We also ask that you continue to educate your employees and contractors on acceptable conduct and their responsibility as stewards.

Thank you for your consideration and for bringing this important matter to the attention of the Committee.
