

## **Parking Amendment - Glengrove Avenue**

### **SUMMARY**

---

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is recommending that parking be prohibited from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, on the south side of Glengrove Avenue, between Danesbury Avenue and Marlee Avenue. Currently parking is allowed for up to three hours in this area. The proposed changes will address residents' concerns with nearby workers parking their vehicle for the entire day.

### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

---

The Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. North York Community Council prohibit parking from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, on the south side of Glengrove Avenue, between Danesbury Avenue and Marlee Avenue.

### **FINANCIAL IMPACT**

---

The signage costs associated with the proposed amendments are approximately \$750.00. Funding is available within the Transportation Services 2025 Operating Budget.

### **DECISION HISTORY**

---

This report addresses a new initiative.

## COMMENTS

---

The Ward Councillor, on behalf of residents of Glengrove Avenue, requested that parking be prohibited from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, on the south side of Glengrove Avenue, between Danesbury Avenue and Marlee Avenue. This was requested because workers from nearby construction sites park for the entire day on Glengrove Avenue.

### Existing Conditions

Glengrove Avenue is characterized by the following conditions:

- It is a two-lane, east/west, local roadway
- It operates two-way traffic on a pavement width of approximately 8.5 metres
- The daily two-way traffic volume is approximately 2,700 vehicles
- The speed limit is 30 km/h
- Heavy trucks are permitted at all times
- There is no TTC service
- There are sidewalks located on both sides of the street
- There is a parkette on the south side of the street with a trail that crosses to the north side to access Wenderly Park

Parking is prohibited at all times on the north side of the subject section of Glengrove Avenue and allowed for a maximum of three-hours on the south side (unsigned).

### Proposed Changes

The proposed 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday parking prohibition on the south side of Glengrove Avenue, between Danesbury Avenue and Marlee Avenue, will address residents' concerns with workers' vehicles parking in this area.

A map of the area and proposed parking amendment is included in Attachment 1.

The Ward Councillor has been advised of the recommendation of this staff report.
