

Parking Amendment - Hamlet Gate

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is recommending that parking be prohibited from December 1 to March 31 of the following year, on the east side of Hamlet Gate, between Bamboo Grove and Denlow Boulevard. Currently parking is allowed for up to three hours on both sides of the street. The proposed changes will address residents' concerns with parked vehicles and plowed snow obstructing traffic.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. North York Community Council prohibit parking from December 1 to March 31 of the following year, inclusive, on the east side of Hamlet Gate, between Bamboo Grove and Denlow Boulevard.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The signage costs associated with the proposed amendments are approximately \$500.00. Funding is available within the Transportation Services 2025 Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

This report addresses a new initiative.

COMMENTS

The Ward Councillor, on behalf of residents of Hamlet Gate, requested that parking be prohibited from December 1 to March 31 of the following year, on the east side of Hamlet Gate, between Bamboo Grove and Denlow Boulevard. This was requested because parents dropping off and picking up their children at Denlow Community Childcare park on both sides of the street, which obstructs traffic when there is plowed snow on the roadway.

Existing Conditions

Hamlet Gate is characterized by the following conditions:

- It is a two-lane, north/south, local roadway
- It operates two-way traffic on a pavement width of approximately 8.5 metres
- The speed limit is 30 km/h
- Heavy trucks are permitted at all times
- There is no TTC service
- There are sidewalks located on both sides of the street
- Denlow Community Childcare is located on the north side of the intersection of Denlow Boulevard and Hamlet Gate

Parking is allowed for a maximum of three-hours (unsigned) on both sides of Hamlet Gate, between Bamboo Grove and Denlow Boulevard.

Proposed Changes

The proposed December 1 to March 31 of the following year parking prohibition, on the east side of Hamlet Gate, between Bamboo Grove and Denlow Boulevard, will address residents' concerns with parked vehicles during the winter.

A map of the area and proposed parking amendment is included in Attachment 1.

The Ward Councillor has been advised of the recommendation of this staff report.
