Re: Three Valleys Drive – 40 km/h speed limit – Motion Memorandum
Wards: Ward 16, Don Valley East

Transportation Services has been requested by a local councillor to provide recommended wording for recommendations they plan to present in a motion to North York Community Council. Staff request that this memorandum accompany the member's submission.

Summary

- Staff do not have sufficient data and/or time to determine if the draft recommendations provided below can be supported by staff, at this time.

Draft Recommendations

1. North York Community Council designate a 40 kilometres per hour speed limit on Three Valleys Drive, between Kestell Lane and the south end of Three Valleys Drive.

Three Valleys Drive is a collector street between Groveland Crescent (east intersection) and Laurentide Drive, and a local street between Laurentide Drive and the south end of the street. The speed limit on Three Valleys Drive is 40 km/h, between Groveland Crescent (east intersection) and Kestell Lane. Three Valleys Public School is located on the north side of this section of the street. The speed limit is 50 km/h on Three Valleys Drive, between Kestell Lane and the south end of the street. As per Vision Zero, Transportation Services recommends a 40 km/h speed limit on collector streets and a 30 km/h speed limit on local streets.

Cost

The signage costs associated with the proposed amendments are approximately \$500. Funding is available within the Transportation Services 2025 Operating Budget.
