**Amending Speed Limits from 50km/h to 40km/h – Lynedock Crescent between Fenside Drive and Roywood Drive (East Intersection)**

Dear Mr. Green,

Lynedock Crescent is both a collector road and local road within Ward 16, the section discussed here is a local road with inconsistent speed limits to the collector portion. The collector portion of the road from Sandover Drive to Fenside Drive is 40km/h, while the remaining stretch East of Fenside Drive to Roywood Drive is 50km/h.

Residents have requested a uniform speed limit of 40km/h for all of Lynedock Crescent. The reason for this change includes:

- The need to eliminate any confusion that could come because of differing speed limits.
- The desire to reduce vehicle operating speed and improve pedestrian safety.

**Recommendation:**

1. North York Community Council designate a 40 kilometres per hour speed limit on Lynedock Crescent, between Fenside Drive and Roywood Drive (east intersection).
