

This location map is for information purposes only; the exact boundaries of the property are not shown. The arrow marks the location of the site.









The Toronto Heritage Grant Program provides matching grant funds for eligible heritage conservation work of residential properties or tax exempt properties in the City of Toronto designated under the Ontario Heritage Act (OHA). Applicants may receive a grant once every five years for up to 50% of the cost of eligible conservation work.

- Owners of house form buildings may receive up to \$10,000.00 every five years, or if replacing an entire cedar or slate roof assembly, up to \$20,000.00 every ten years.
- Owners of non-house form buildings and any tax exempt properties including house-form buildings may be eligible for a grant equivalent to 50% of the cost of eligible conservation work, with no maximum limit






