Over 43 years as a volunteer with Scouts Canada, Rubene exemplified the spirit of the Scouting movement. He served locally and nationally, with the 78th Toronto Group at St. Sebastian Catholic School, as Area Commissioner for Skyline Area, as Deputy National Commissioner of Communications, and on the leadership team for several national and international Scouting events. He also served the World Scouting Movement as a Member of the Interamerican Scout Foundation's Board of Trustees. On July 7, 2025, Rubene was posthumously award the Silver Wolf, Scouts Canada's highest national award recognizing service of the most exceptional character with impact across the country.

In addition to his professional and Scouting life, Rubene was a committed parishioner of Santa Cruz Portuguese Catholic Church who helped the church community stay connected online during the COVID-19 pandemic. Rubene was a graduate of the University of Toronto and Centennial College.
