Re: Traffic Calming (Speed Humps) - Huntsmill Boulevard
Wards: Ward 22, Scarborough-Agincourt

Transportation Services is requesting the Ward 22 Councillor to re-open item SC22.10 to amend the recommendation to install speed humps on Huntsmill Boulevard at the June 5, 2025, Scarborough Community Council. Staff request that this memorandum accompany the Councillor's letter.

Summary

- Staff do not have sufficient data and/or time to determine if the draft recommendations provided below can be supported by staff, at this time.

Draft Recommendations

1. Scarborough Community Council re-open Item SC22.10, titled "Huntsmill Boulevard - Traffic Calming (Speed Humps)".
2. Scarborough Community Council amend its previous decision by:
 - a. adding the words "(south intersection)" to references of Bamburgh Circle, so that the recommendations read as follows:
 1. Scarborough Community Council authorize the installation of speed humps on Huntsmill Boulevard, between Bamburgh Circle (south intersection) and Arnall Avenue.
 2. Scarborough Community Council direct the City Solicitor to prepare a by-law to alter the roadway for the installation of 14 speed humps on Huntsmill Boulevard, between Bamburgh Circle (south intersection) and Arnall Avenue, generally as shown on Attachments 2, 3, and 4, Drawings TC-480, TC-481, and TC-482, dated April 2025, attached to the report entitled "Traffic Calming (Speed Humps) - Huntsmill Boulevard" from the Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services.

3. *Subject to approval of Recommendations 1 and 2 above, Scarborough Community Council reduce the speed limit from 40 km/h to 30 km/h on Huntsmill Boulevard, between Bamburgh Circle (south intersection) and Arnall Avenue, in conjunction with the installation of speed humps.*

At its meeting on May 1, 2025, Scarborough Community Council approved speed humps on Huntsmill Boulevard, between Bamburgh Circle and Arnall Avenue. There are two Huntsmill Boulevard and Bamburgh Circle intersections: the south intersection and the north intersection. The initial recommendations did not state the south or north intersection. Accordingly, Transportation Services is requesting a re-opening of Item 2025.SC22.10 to correct the wording of the recommendations to include a “south intersection” description for Huntsmill Boulevard and Bamburgh Circle intersection. As the previous approval was less than one year ago, Council procedures require that the previous item be re-opened and amended.
